12 Dance Consortium venues present *Pepperland* in Spring 2019. *Pepperland by* Mark Morris Dance Group is a one-act dance commissioned by Liverpool City Council in 2017 as a unique tribute to the 50th anniversary of The Beatles' *Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band*.

The one-act dance explores the sights and sounds of the 1960s. Brightly-dressed characters are cool and playful. Wearing shades, 15 dancers groove, slink and skip through 12 musical numbers. Mark Morris's signature choreographic style draws from modern dance, ballet and folk and is precise, fluid and fun.

The 11 musical tracks, played live by a seven piece chamber orchestra, are a mix of re-scored songs from The Beatles' including *When I'm 64, Penny Lane* and *A Day in the Life* plus some new music by lyersen.

Participation and Engagement

Dance Consortium works with tour venues to run participation and value-added events to extend the reach of the show. These include talks, workshops, masterclasses and Dance for PD sessions. A Pepperland Study Guide has been produced for the tour. Contact Fiona.ross@danceconsortium.com

Foyer animation and linked activities

- A Beatles-themed open house includes a lobby exhibition, which features memorabilia, costumes, art, posters, music, videos, a photo booth, a live theremin demonstration.
- A public lecture on The Sixties by a local professor discussing the cultural, social and political issues of the decade.
- Mark Morris has curated a series of 20 films made in the 1960s including Blow Up, A Hard Day's Night, Night of the Living Dead, Cat Ballou and Barbarella. Some presenters have screened (or arranged screenings at a local/partner cinema) a selected number of films leading up to the company visit. While in residence, Mark has given introductions at specific screenings.
- Post-show Sixties disco and photo-booth
- A community "Dance with MMDG" dance class offered for participants of all ages and abilities, taught by company members
- Theremin demonstration or mini-concert
- A talk with choreographer Mark Morris and composer Ethan Iverson

Talks and music events

Post show talks are scheduled on the first night at each venue. Talks after the second performance can also be arranged. These are advertised as featuring 'members of the company' and they will rotate contributors including Mark Morris, composer Ethan Iverson, dancers and musicians.

Music talks or music demonstrations can be arranged with Ethan Iverson



Event scheduling & costs:

- One workshop on opening day
- One two workshops on second day (no mat)
- Two activities are included in the venue performance fee.
- Accompanists costs and local travel are payable.

Dance with MMDG family workshops

"Dance with MMDG" is a one-hour multigenerational workshops for all ages (2-102!). These are popular family workshops run in a studio, community space or activate a theatre foyer space. Group sizes up to 80 depending on space.

Dance workshops and masterclasses

Practical workshops give a fantastic insight into Mark Morris's movement style and approach to dance-making. Workshops feature themes and repertoire from Pepperland suitable for all ages:

- Dance or Performing Arts students (2 hrs)
- Youth dance
- Schools (resource pack available)
- Community groups and older people

Masterclasses and CPD events

Masterclasses can be offered to advanced or professional level dancers. Classes in ballet or modern explore Mark Morris's choreography and feature a warm-up, repertoire and a choreographic component. C PD workshops for teachers.

Backstage Tours

Technical Director and set designer Johan Henckens leads free 20 minute tours of the Pepperland stage set and costumes.

Restorative dance for older people

A 1 hr-1.15hr dance workshop featuring a gentle warm up class, infusing Mark Morris's rep into travelling and movement sequences. Accessible to both seated and standing participants.

Dance for Parkinson's Disease

Mark Morris Dance Group's Dance for PD® programme works to increase coordination, balance, flexibility, and strength through regular movement classes. Watch this short film for more information: https://youtu.be/2sqo5fZ H5A
